

**CITY OF SOUTHGATE
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
November 2, 2016
City Building, 122 Electric Ave**

Call to Order: Mayor Hamberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

The following answered roll call: Council Members Enzweiler, Robisch, Anderson, and Speier were present. Council Members Hayley and Payne were absent. Also present: Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson, City Clerk Barton, Police Lieutenant Collinsworth for Chief Christmann, and City Attorney Mary Ann Stewart. Public Works Foreman Bowman and Fire Chief Beatsch were absent.

Public Comments: Park and Tree Board Co Chair Joyce Hamberg presented the Green Thumb Awards for October. The winners were: Paul & Bridget Payne (11 W. Walnut) and Mike Lycans & Patty Hollan (103 Harvard).

Cindy Minter, Director of Campbell Co. Planning and Zoning gave a presentation on the potential rezoning application made to the City of Southgate for Blossom Ln. Several residents spoke about their concerns of their property and Blossom Ln. **There was a motion for the first reading of Ordinance 16-12 Amend zoning for Blossom Ln. to go in tandem with the discussion. Motion/Second: Robisch/Anderson. Approved by voice vote: Aye 4 Nay 0.**

Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes of 10/19/16. Motion/Second: Robisch/Enzweiler. Approved by voice vote: Aye 4 Nay 0.

Public Works: Councilman Anderson reported that Public Works replaced the dead rose bushes by the volleyball court with high grass plantings. Curbs were replaced on Bonnie and Center St. Councilman Speier inquired about streets that need repair/patching. Mayor Hamberg said to contact Public Works Foreman Bowman.

Public Safety: Council Member Speier had no report. Police Lieutenant Collinsworth stated that Officer Wilson has moved from part-time to full-time status. There was some discussion of vandalism that occurred on Halloween night.

Code Enforcement: Council Member Enzweiler said that there were 19 active cases.

Community Relations & Recreation: No report.

Public Buildings: Councilman Robisch reported that the fan in the firehouse was re-fastened to the wall and the doorbell is working.

Finance and Administration: Council Member Hayley was absent. **A motion was made to approve the Sept. financials. Motion/Second: Speier/Anderson. Approved by voice vote: Aye 4 Nay 0.**

Finance Director/Treasurer Hudson said the City can pay \$225,000 on the TAN loan due to recent real estate tax collections. City Clerk Barton had no report. City Attorney Stewart had no report, but read the following Ordinances/Orders:

Order 16-06 Re-appointing Mike Williams to Campbell Co. Planning & Zoning Commission was read. Mayor Hamberg said that he would sign the order.

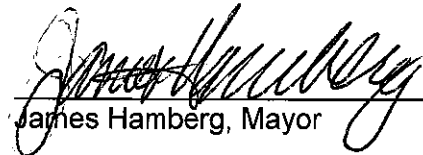
Old Business: none.
